Training on COVID-19 for Education Department, Himachal Pradesh A Report

A Training Programme on COVID-19 for the colleges of five districts *viz*. Bilaspur, Kullu, Lahul & Spiti, Chamba and Kinnaur was organised on 24th June, 2021from 11am to 1 pm under the webinar series on COVID-19 by the Department of Higher education with the support of the NHM, H.P. Govt. State Red Cross Society & the State Institute of Health & Family Welfare, Pari Mahal, Shimla. A total number of 21 teachers including **Dr. Mandeep Sharma**, the Principal, participated from Govt. College Banjar Distt. Kullu.

The objective of the programme was to sensitize the teachers with the role of the nutrition for staying healthy, COVID appropriate behaviour, and psychosocial care in the COVID-19 pandemic as well as to acquaint them with the myths and facts related to Covid Vaccination and give them a chance to seek answers to their queries with a view that the teachers will disseminate information to their students and society at large.

After that, the first resource person **Dr. Harsharan Kaur**, Principal SIHEN spoke on the **Role of Nutrition** for staying healthy. She talked about the food and the meal plan for the day which promote health and protect from diseases by boosting our immunity.

The second resource person, **Dr. Rakhi Sharma** talked about **COVID Appropriate Behaviour** and stressed the need of understanding new normal during the pandemic. She spoke about 15 points of COVID appropriate behaviour that everyone needs to follow.

Dr. Sanjay Pathak, Senior MS Mental Hospital, Boileuganj and CEO State Mental Health Authority, Shimla, Himachal Pradesh, the third resource person, talked on the issue of **Psychosocial Care during COVID-19 Pandemic.** He highlighted how the Pandemic has social, economic and psychological implication thereby causing many mental health problems.
