

Webinar on “Assessment and Accreditation Process of NAAC – 28th May, 2021” – A Report

29th May, 2021

A webinar on Assessment and Accreditation process of NAAC was organized collaboratively by GC Kullu, GC Banjar and JLN GC Haripur, Manali on 28th May 2021 at 12 noon through Google Meet. Professor (Dr. Sunil Gupta), former Vice Chancellor, HPU and presently Chairman, HP State Education Council was the keynote speaker. All the principals and the staff members of the aforementioned colleges attended the webinar.

Mrs. Bandana Vaidya, Principal, GC Kullu, and Dr. Mandeep Sharma, Principal, GC Banjar welcomed the keynote speaker Dr. Sunil Gupta. Dr. Gupta highlighted the need and significance of accreditation as well as the procedural details of the revised process for Assessment and Accreditation. He explained in detail about the submission of the Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) along with the fee, the Self Study Report (SSR), the Pre-qualifier Stage, Student Satisfaction Survey, Peer Team Visit, Assessment Outcome etc. Then he explained the Quality Indicator Framework (QIF) and the seven Criteria which serve as the basis of assessment, the Key Indicators, i.e. Metrics – Qualitative and Quantitative, the Distribution of Metrics and Weightage across Metrics. All the seven criteria viz. Curricular Aspects, Teaching Learning and Evaluation, Research, Innovations and Extension, Infrastructure and Learning Resources, Student Support and Progression, Governance, Leadership and Management, and Institutional Values and Best practices were explained in detail. Dr. Gupta also gave suggestions as to how institutions can improve their scores and answered the queries from the teaching staff.

The webinar came to an end with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Bipan Rathore, Principal JLN GC Haripur, Manali.
