This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made on 27 November, 2025 by and between the Govt. Degree College Banjar, Kullu, Himachal Pradesh & Pratibha Spandan, Long View, Jutogh, Shimla, Himachal Pradesh. Foundation of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on Academic Cooperation:

- That the exchange of knowledge and experiences between the members, faculty, students & scholars of both the organisations are of great significance for their progress and service to society;
- That both the organisations aspire to strengthen the academic areas;
- That both the institutions understand that the agreement does not bind them to any financial commitments or obligations.

Pratibha Spandan, Shimla and Govt. Degree College Banjar, Kullu, for the purpose of strengthening the ties between the two organisations, hereby affirm their intent to promote the academic collaboration and exchanges as will be of mutual benefit to the two organisations. This MOU will cover following areas:

ARTICLE 1: Organizing Collaborative Programs

- To organize conferences, seminars, symposium, workshops, lectures, training programmes as well as other academic activities based on different themes of respective subjects for the benefit of the faculty and students as well.
- To organize awareness programmes, camps etc. on various issues such as HIV/AIDS, human trafficking, terrorism, gender injustice, alcoholism, illiteracy, population explosion, environmental issues, community welfare, employability, health and education and other contemporary issues.
- To organise various activities to create awareness among common public regarding etc.
- To provide guidance and counselling to the students in various areas.

ARTICLE 2: Publication of Research Outcome

- The two parties will contribute to academic publications in journals and other publications of joint research projects and they will cooperate in authorship. All publications generated directly from this cooperation will clearly mention the collaboration between the two institutes.

ARTICLE 3: Extension Activities

- To promote culture, yoga, human values and ethics, Indian tradition and heritage etc. among students, faculty and community through various social activities.
- To provide a forum for the exchange of ideas on the social, cultural and educational conditions of society.
- To collaborate on other mutual areas of interest.

ARTICLE 4: Validity of the Agreement

- This MOU takes the effect from the date of its ratification by the appropriate bodies in both the institutes in accordance with their respective statutes.

- The validity of this MOU extends over two years. The renewed MOU can be extended further for subsequent terms of two years each on getting written consent of both the parties.
- The terms of this MOU will be carried out according to the executive procedures stipulated, in accordance with the laws and regulations in forces by the concerned council's/ governing bodies of the two Institutes.
- Any disagreement on the interpretation or implementation of this agreement shall be resolved through amicable and diplomatic means without involving a third party.

NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

- Either of the parties by giving one month's notice in writing to the other party may terminate this Agreement before its expiry.
- Both parties shall also have the right to terminate the agreement without prior notice if
 - There occurs a breach of any terms of this Agreement which remains uncured for a period of fifteen (15) days after being notified in writing to the other party;
 - Either of the parties commits any act or omission which harms the reputation of the other party;
 - Either of the party acts in a manner prejudicial to the interest of the other and affected Party shall be the sole judge in this regard.

Expiry or termination of this Agreement howsoever occasioned shall be without prejudice to rights, obligations occurred or incurred prior to the date of expiry or termination, and accounts between the parties shall be promptly settled.

Both parties acknowledge that they have read this agreement, understood it, and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.

This agreement will become effective from 27-11.2025
